PROCESS STEPS



PURPOSE

- Fundamentals**
 - These programs are developed for newly certified home health agency staff including administration, billing and clinical; new staff of an existing agency (including occupational and physical therapists, and speech language pathologists); and private duty agency administrators considering becoming a Medicare certified agency.
- Intermediate**
 - These programs are developed for certified home health agency staff with at least one to two years experience in management, administration, billing and clinical; to enhance the operational performance of the agency and to increase their professional development skills & knowledge.
- Advanced**
 - These programs are developed for certified home health agency staff with at least 4 years experience in management, administration, billing and clinical; to accelerate operational performance of their home health agency and to expand their professional development skills & knowledge.
- Certifications**
 - These programs are designed to enhance next level professional development as a certified caregiver or in a healthcare executive role.
